This should not exceed one typed, single spaced page.
- Based on your knowledge of the sections in a yearbook, discuss two ideas you would like to incorporate into the book and how they would make the yearbook stronger. This should not exceed two paragraphs.
- Attach an essay which shows your writing strengths and style. This may either be original or a previous assignment from one of your classes. If you use a previous assignment, please copy the prompt at the top of your paper. This should be a 1-2 page typed paper.
- Interview a family member or friend and write a “standout.” The person can be interviewed over the phone if need be. List questions you asked the person and then write a story about them and their hobbies, extracurriculars, passions, etc., incorporating quotes from the interview. This should only be about a paragraph long (or around 250 words).
